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## **PRESS RELEASE**

The Following activities have been undertaken by the Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission in the past four years.

### **ACHIEVEMENTS IN INVESTIGATION**

- 498 investigations files have been completed and forwarded to AG
- KACC has in the past investigated and recommended to the Attorney General for Prosecution 8 Ministers, 5 in the former and 3 in the current Coalition Government, 3 members of parliament, 8 former permanent secretaries, 58 Chief Executives of Public Corporations and 89 Senior Officials and Managers in Government and State Corporations.
- 16 members of the 10th parliament have being sued by KACC for receiving irregular allowances.
- Recovered corruptly acquired assets valued at Ksh 4.5 billion which included -Grand Regency, Karura forest, KARI plots, By-passes, Woodley estate
- Over 250 persons have been arraigned in court on corruption charges
- Has filed 398 recovery suits valued approximately Ksh 5 billion
- Numerous Applications filed to search premises and investigate accounts

### **PRO-ACTIVE INTERVENTIONS**

- Conducted Seven (7) covert investigations leading to disruptions of corruptions valued approximately Ksh 4.66 billion as follows:

### **ASSET RECOVERY / RESTITUTION**

- Recovered 14 Corruptly acquired property valued at Ksh 158.5 million
- Recovered cash amounting to Ksh 5.8 million from 7 persons
- Filed 153 recovery suits worth Ksh 5 billion
- 142 Application for injunction to prevent wasting or alienation of public property

### **PUBLIC EDUCATION**

- 4.9 million Kenyans sensitized, educated, through the media programmes and IEC materials which have been disseminated to over 690,000 persons/institutions
- Developed Curriculum support materials (4 bookmarks, 4 brochures, 6 booklets, 2 teachers guides) for learning institutions (Kindergarten to class 8). Prison service, KIA, AP have mainstreamed anti-corruption content in their training programmes
- Developed Bible Study Guide which has been distributed for use in religious organizations

## PREVENTION SERVICES

- Conducted 10 sector wide examinations into the Roads Sub-sector, KEMSA, Teachers Service Commission, Pensions Department, Civil Registration Department and National Registration Bureau, Local Authority Transfer Fund (LATF). Nairobi City Council, Department of Immigration, Motor Vehicle Registration and Licensing
- Conducted 2 Corruption Risk Assessments of Mombasa Municipal Council and Kenya Maritime Authority
- Developed , in collaboration with key institutions, Corruption Prevention Guidelines on ICT as well as Corruption Prevention Guidelines on Public Procurement
- Provided advisory services to 423 institutions through inclusion of anti corruption targets in the public sector performance contracting framework. The targets include preparation of Codes of conduct and Ethics, institutional corruption prevention policies, conduct of risk assessments and corruption baseline surveys; and preparation of Corruption prevention plans
- Provided other advisory services on how to mainstream corruption prevention strategies to over 209 public and private sector institutions and extended services to Southern Sudan Anti Corruption Commission and the Directorate on Corruption and Economic Crimes of Botswana.
- Conducted integrity training for over 1930 integrity assurance officers in 251 public institutions, 163 Corruption Prevention Committees of Public institutions
- Conducted Capacity building for members of tender Committees from 149 Local Authorities on corruption prevention in the procurement function
- Conducted capacity building for 76 Insurance Branch and Claims Managers on fraud prevention in the insurance industry; Good governance programmes for members of professional associations; and corruption prevention in the construction industry for SMEs.

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
