

# DIRECTORATE OF INVESTIGATIONS AND ASSET TRACING

MONTHLY REPORT FOR NOVEMBER, 2007

#### Reports and Data Centre - Nairobi

During the month of **November 2007**, the Reports and Data Department has processed a total of **340** (new) reports. After analysis and classification, **58** reports disclosed (possible) offences within the mandate of the Commission and were dealt with as follows: **16** cases were forwarded to the Special Operations Department for immediate action and **42** called for preliminary investigations and were consequently forwarded to the Intelligence Production Department.


The remaining 282 cases were found to be outside the Commission's mandate and were disposed of as follows:

- i. 17 cases were forwarded to other investigative agencies for action- with the Criminal Investigations Department accounting for 10, Police 2, KRA 2, Banking Fraud 1 and the Immigration Department 2.
- ii. 48 cases to various public service organisations for administrative intervention,
- iii. in 61 cases the complainants were advised to seek civil redress,
- iv. in 147 cases the complainants were advised on the right authority to report to and
- v. 9 after analysis were recommended for No Further Action


In the same period a total of 138 clients/informants visited the Department to lodge reports and /or seek advice. Of this number, 116 were visiting the Commission for the first time, while the remaining 22 were following up on their cases.

#### Comparative Analysis Showing the Cases received for the past 6 months.




#### **Reports and Data Centre - Mombasa**






