










On behalf of the Kenya Anti-Corruption Advisory Board and Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission, we wish to assure the entire Staff of the Commission, our clients and all Kenyans that pursuant to the enactment of Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission, the Commission shall continue to exist to serve this Country, and in particular that:

- (i) The Advisory Board shall oversee the operations of the Commission for the next three (3) months or until the new Commissioners assume office.
- (ii) Necessary transition from the Director and his Assistant Directors to appropriate managers be appointed by the Advisory Board within a week.
- (iii) The Director and his Assistants will be given ample time to handover their responsibilities to those managers.
- (iv) The investigations, court cases and other activities of the Commission shall continue as usual.

- (v) The assets, records, documents of the Commission will be fully safeguarded.

Whilst the Advisory Board has concerns over the amendments and repealing of the Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act 2003, we assure all the remaining staff that the Advisory Board has confidence in their work and the Nation expects them to continue with achieving their performance goals.
