The Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission will be launching the commencement of an examination assignment into the registration and licensing of motor vehicles across the country. The examination will lead to the identification of weaknesses, loopholes, avenues and opportunities that can be used for corrupt practices in the systems, policies and procedures in the operations of the department of Motor Vehicles, the Transport Licensing Board and the Motor Vehicle Inspection Unit. In the process of assessing the degree of accountability, integrity and transparency in the key functional areas, the Commission will provide appropriate advice in order to seal these loopholes and enhance governance and integrity in the departments.

The examination is a result of persistent complaints by the members of the public either through the media or to the Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission on various forms of corrupt practices in the process of registration and licensing of motor vehicles.

Chief Executives and Senior Officers from Motor Vehicle Inspection Unit, Transport Licensing Board, Ministry of Finance, Traffic Police and Kenya Revenue Authority will attend the Launch, which will be at Norfolk Hotel on Friday 1st April 2005 from 3:15pm.
