
## **Report Centre - Nairobi**

During the month of **April 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **254** (new) reports. The number of reports received and processed has been on the rise as compared to earlier this year where an all time record low of **179** reports were received in February.

After analysis and classification the reports were disposed off follows:

- The Commission took up for investigation 72 reports found to be within its mandate. The Intelligence Production Department accounted for 44 of the cases. The Rapid Response Division took up 25 cases for investigations, Forensic Investigation Department took up 1 case and the Legal Services Department took up the remaining 2 cases.
- 6 cases were forwarded to other investigative agencies for action- with the Criminal Investigations Department accounting for 3, Immigration 2 and KRA 1.
- 21 cases were referred to various public service organisations for administrative intervention,
- In 37 cases the complainants were advised to seek civil redress,
- In 113 cases the complainants were advised on the right authority to report to
- After analysis of **5** reports, they were marked as requiring No Further Action


#### Categorization of reports Processed by KACC in April 2008

Comparative Analysis Showing the Cases received for the past 5 months.










Comparative Analysis of Cases processed in March 2008 and April 2008






Graphical Representation of the cases processed.
