

# DIRECTORATE OF INVESTIGATIONS AND ASSET TRACING

**MONTHLY REPORT, JULY 2008** 

#### Introduction


The Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing is one of the four Directorates of the Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission. The functions of the Directorate are to;

- Investigate Corruption and Economic Crimes as stipulated in the Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act (2003).
- Investigate the extent of liability, loss or damage to any public property for purposes of recovery or compensation,
- Investigate and trace the whereabouts of corruptly acquired assets for purposes of recovery.
- Assist any law enforcement agency in the country in investigation of corruption or economic crimes.

In January 2008, the Directorate was reorganised into three departments, namely; Operations, Forensics and Intelligence.

- i. Operations- comprising two divisions; Report Centre and Rapid Response,
- ii. Forensics- comprising two divisions; Forensic Investigation and Asset Tracing,
- iii. Intelligence- comprising three divisions: Analysis & Production, Preliminary Investigation and Collection

#### **Structure of the Directorate**



#### **Mombasa Office**

The Mombasa Regional Office, which is under the Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing, commenced operations on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2007 and was officially launched on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2007. All the three departments of the Directorate, namely; Forensic Investigation (FI), Operations (OPS) and Intelligence Production (IP) are represented.


#### Report Centre - Nairobi

During the month of **July 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **432** (new) reports. The number of reports received and processed has been on the rise as compared to earlier this year where an all time record low of **179** reports were received in February.

After analysis and classification the reports were disposed off follows:

- The Commission took up for investigation 104 reports found to be within its mandate. The Intelligence Production Department accounted for 64 of the cases, Rapid Response Division took up 36 cases, and Forensics Department took up 3 cases while 1 case was forwarded to the Legal Services Directorate.
- 30 cases were forwarded to other investigative agencies for action- with the Criminal Investigations Department accounting for 9, Immigration 11, KRA 5 and Police 5.
- 51 cases were referred to various public service organisations for administrative intervention,
- In **60** cases the complainants were advised to seek civil redress,
- In 175 cases the complainants were advised on the right authority to report to
- After analysis of 5 reports, they were marked as requiring No Further Action
- In 7 cases, the complainants were requested to avail more information.


#### Categorization of reports Processed by KACC in July 2008

# Comparative Analysis showing the % of cases taken up by the Commission over the past 2 years



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
## **Report Centre - Mombasa**





## Comparative Analysis of Cases processed in June 2008 and July 2008






#### **Reports**
