#### Introduction


The Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing is one of the four Directorates of the Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission. The functions of the Directorate are to;

- Investigate Corruption and Economic Crimes as stipulated in the Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act (2003).
- Investigate the extent of liability, loss or damage to any public property for purposes of recovery or compensation,
- Investigate and trace the whereabouts of corruptly acquired assets for purposes of recovery.
- Assist any law enforcement agency in the country in investigation of corruption or economic crimes.

In January 2008, the Directorate was reorganised into three departments, namely; Operations, Forensics and Intelligence.

- i. Operations- comprising two divisions; Report Centre and Rapid Response,
- ii. Forensics- comprising two divisions; Forensic Investigation and Asset Tracing,
- iii. Intelligence- comprising three divisions: Analysis & Production, Preliminary Investigation and Collection

#### **Structure of the Directorate**



#### **Mombasa Office**

The Mombasa Regional Office, which is under the Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing, commenced operations on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2007 and was officially launched on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2007. All the three departments of the Directorate, namely; Forensic Investigation (FI), Operations (OPS) and Intelligence Production (IP) are represented.


#### Report Centre - Nairobi

During the month of **October 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **320** (new) reports as compared to **378** reports received in September, 2008. The number of reports received is slowly on the rise with an average of about **302** reports per month. This however, is still relatively low as compared to last year's average of about **616** reports per month during the same period

After analysis and classification the reports were disposed off follows:

- The Commission took up for investigation **97** reports found to be within its mandate. The Intelligence Production Department accounted for **61** of the cases, Rapid Response Division took up **31** cases, Forensics Investigations took up **4** cases, and the Legal Services Directorate took up **1** case.
- 8 cases were forwarded to other investigative agencies for action with the Criminal Investigations Department accounting for 3, Immigration 4 and KRA 1.
- 40 cases were referred to various public service organisations for administrative intervention,
- In 40 cases the complainants were advised to seek civil redress,
- In 117 cases the complainants were advised on the right authority to report to
- After analysis of 6 reports, they were marked as requiring No Further Action (NFA)
- In 12 cases, the complainants were requested to avail more information.


#### Categorization of reports Processed by KACC in October 2008

#### Report Centre - Mombasa

During the month of **October 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **29** new reports. After analysis and classification the reports were disposed off as follows:-

- A total of 7 reports were within the mandate of KACC and were taken up for investigation. 3 of the cases went to Intelligence Production, 3 were taken by Rapid Response while 1 were assigned to Forensic Investigations.
- 1 case was forwarded to the Provincial Investigations Officer Coast.
- 1 to Kenya Revenue Authority
- 3 complainants were advised to seek civil redress
- In 17 cases complainants were advised on the right authority to refer their complaints.









#### **Disseminated Intelligence Briefs to Management**

- 1. **NSSF Brief** on various investments by NSSF, suspicious disposal of the funds assets and other irregularities by the management.
- 2. **Grain Bulk Handling Brief-** on cancellation of tender for introduction of an alternative bulk grain handling firm at the Port of Mombasa by the KPA management.

#### **Intelligence Production – Mombasa**

The Department received 3 reports from the Report Centre and 6 intelligence reports from its intelligence sources during the month under review. The Intelligence reports concerned alleged irregular release of containers at the Mombasa Port without the relevant taxes being paid. It was recommended that the containers be stopped pending verification to ascertain the veracity of the allegations and the information was forwarded to the Investigations Branch of KRA for action.

During the month, the Intelligence Team continued with preliminary investigations into two cases commenced in the month of September 2008.

In addition the Intelligence Team carried out the following activities:

- Intelligence investigations into a reportedly long running tax evasion scheme at the port of Mombasa involving a cartel of customs officials, clearing agents and importers.
- A covert investigation into allegations of procurement irregularities relating to the award of a contract to a firm for bulk fertilizer handling by the Kenya Ports Authority.
