Introduction


The Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing is one of the four Directorates of the Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission. The functions of the Directorate are to;

- Investigate Corruption and Economic Crimes as stipulated in the Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act (2003).
- Investigate the extent of liability, loss or damage to any public property for purposes of recovery or compensation,
- Investigate and trace the whereabouts of corruptly acquired assets for purposes of recovery.
- Assist any law enforcement agency in the country in investigation of corruption or economic crimes.

In January 2008, the Directorate was reorganised into three departments, namely; Operations, Forensics and Intelligence.

- i. Operations- comprising two divisions; Report Centre and Rapid Response,
- ii. Forensics- comprising two divisions; Forensic Investigation and Asset Tracing,
- iii. Intelligence- comprising three divisions: Analysis & Production, Preliminary Investigation and Collection

Structure of the Directorate



Mombasa Office

The Mombasa Regional Office, which is under the Directorate of Investigation and Asset Tracing, commenced operations on 4th September 2007 and was officially launched on 4th December 2007. All the three departments of the Directorate, namely; Forensic Investigation (FI), Operations (OPS) and Intelligence Production (IP) are represented.


Report Centre - Nairobi

During the month of **September 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **378** (new) reports as compared to 342 reports received in August, 2008. The number of reports received is slowly on the rise with an average of about **291** reports per month. This however, is still relatively low as compared to last year's average of about **656** reports per month during the same period

After analysis and classification the reports were disposed off follows:

- The Commission took up for investigation 97 reports found to be within its mandate. The Intelligence Production Department accounted for 64 of the cases, Rapid Response Division took up 31 cases, Forensics Investigations took up 1 case, and the Legal Services Directorate took up 1 case.
- 16 cases were forwarded to other investigative agencies for action- with the Criminal Investigations Department accounting for 5, Immigration 5, KRA 2 and Police 5.
- 55 cases were referred to various public service organisations for administrative intervention,
- In 42 cases the complainants were advised to seek civil redress,
- In 153 cases the complainants were advised on the right authority to report to
- After analysis of 6 reports, they were marked as requiring No Further Action (NFA)
- In 9 cases, the complainants were requested to avail more information.


Categorization of reports Processed by KACC in September 2008

Report Centre - Mombasa

During the month of **September 2008**, the Reports Centre Division processed **45** new reports. After analysis and classification the **45** reports were disposed off as follows:-

- A total of 13 reports were within the mandate of KACC and were taken up for investigation. 4 of the cases went to Intelligence Production, 6 were taken by Rapid Response while 3 were assigned to Forensic Investigations.
- 1 case was forwarded to the Provincial Investigations Officer Coast.
- 1 to Provincial Commissioner Nyanza
- 9 complainants were advised to seek civil redress
- 21 cases complainants were advised on the right authority to refer their complaints.









Coverage for the Administration Police Recruitment

The Kenya Administration Police conducted a countrywide recruitment for Administration Police Constables on 24th September 2008 that was undertaken simultaneously at all District and Sub-District Headquarters. The Commission monitored the recruitment exercise at selected centres. A report has been compiled for submission.

Intelligence Production – Mombasa

The Department received **5** reports from the Report Centre and **2** Intelligence Report from its intelligence sources during the month under review. The Intelligence Report resulted in the seizure of one container suspected to have been released irregularly at the port of Mombasa. During the month, the department commenced three preliminary investigations; **one** has been completed whereas **two** are still ongoing. In addition, the department undertook the following activities:

- Collection of documents and information at the Mombasa Municipal Council to assist Forensic Investigation officers from headquarters who are carrying an investigation into irregular acquisition of a Geographical Information System at the Council and embezzlement of Council revenue. The investigation emanated from an intelligence report filed by Intelligence Production, Mombasa.
- Collection of information and documents from the Mombasa Municipal Council on the request of the Legal Directorate regarding development of an irregularly acquired road reserve on Tom Mboya Street.
