ILLEGALLY ACQUIRED AND UNEXPLAINED ASSETS TRACED

In the period between July 1, 2017 to 30^{th} September, 2018, the Commission completed 13 asset tracing inquiries in respect of public assets illegally acquired. These assets included land/immovable properties and cash. The total estimated value of the assets is **KES 4,627,590,679** as indicated below.
