CALL FOR COMMENTS AND INVITATION FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE DRAFT MODEL PROCEDURES FOR PREVENTION OF BRIBERY AND CORRUPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 9 OF THE ANTI-BRIBERY ACT, 2016.

The Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (the 'Commission') wishes to bring to the attention of all public and private entities, public officers and the public to whom the Anti-Bribery Act, 2016 (the 'Act') applies of the following requirement under the Act-

Section 9(1) of the Act requires private and public entities to whom the Act applies to put in place procedures appropriate to their size, scale and to the nature of their operations, for the prevention of bribery and corruption.

In this regard, the Commission in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Justice and other stakeholders has developed the draft Model Procedures for Prevention of Bribery and Corruption, pursuant to section 9(1) of the Act. These Model Procedures have been publicized in the Commission's website www.eacc.go.ke and the website of the Office of the Attorney General and Department of Justice www.statelaw.go.ke.

All public and private entities, public officers and members of the public are hereby invited to submit comments, input or memoranda on the said Model Procedures, in the following format-
